	Received \$189K or 51% more than last year for PLF, since the taxes were filed in April and paid in May. Last year people filed in May and was paid in June. Year to date will even out. Received settlement for first half of property taxes. We can expect advances in September. Investments earned about \$1.5K, \$2.76 million balance. Market is very volatile. Legacy thinks we are in a good place; we are matching benchmarks and parameters. Donations totaled \$11K. Friends funded the Café. Received \$1k from Hudson League for Service. Received grant for \$5K for Juneteenth program.			
	Molly moved more money over to purchase more bonds. Total portfolio should earn about 2.6%, and they are all staggered (2 to 24 months). Also moved money into Star Ohio because it is earning almost 1%. Opened capital account with Legacy.
